

Course Overview

The Rough Diamond Evaluation Course is an intensive, hands-on training programme designed to equip learners with the practical skills and technical knowledge required to confidently assess and evaluate natural rough diamonds.

Throughout the course, students work directly with a wide selection of natural rough diamond, gaining real-world exposure that mirrors professional sorting, valuation, and manufacturing environments.

Learners develop a strong foundation in the **4Cs of diamond evaluation**—Clarity, Colour, Cut-potential, and Carat Weight—while also learning how these characteristics influence value, planning decisions, and manufacturing outcomes. By the end of the programme, graduates will be able to make informed, defensible decisions regarding the quality and potential of rough diamonds.

What You Will Learn

Core Skill Development

- Identification and interpretation of **clarity/ quality features** in rough diamond
- Assessing **colour and fluorescence** in natural diamonds
- Understanding **crystal shapes, grain structure, Stress, and natural defects**
- Evaluating potential for **polished yield, cut orientation, and value optimisation**
- Hands-on experience in **sorting, classifying, and valuation methodology**
- Practical exercises in **planning and decision-making** used in diamond buying centres, tender environments, and manufacturing operations

- Overview of the modern rough diamond pipeline and ethical sourcing
- The role of international **certification systems**, including the Kimberley Process
- Current trends affecting rough diamond markets
- How evaluation influences downstream manufacturing and pricing
